Where to get the disinfectant, if there are no available on the market?

Beginning of March, Bilfinger Tebodin equipped all offices with sanitizers. However, in some locations it was challenging to get the required amount – for instance, in some parts of the Czech Republic.

Process engineers at Bilfinger Tebodin, specialized in the chemical industry took it as a challenge, which is close to their technical focus. Our colleagues in Pardubice searched for an available recipe, made recalculations and tested the substance.

'We can help each other and deal with any problem, even in this emergency. For most of us, it was a return to student years, when we were regularly working in the laboratory' – says Tomas Mercl, Process engineer at Bilfinger Tebodin.

If you want to prepare your own disinfectant, use the [guide of World Health Organization](#), as our colleagues did. Tomas reminds you of safety measures: the mixture is flammable if isopropyl alcohol is used. In this case hydrogen peroxide could decrease the ignition temperature. Also avoid hot surfaces and sparks and get in touch with our process engineers for details!
